



3 Steps to create, release and track

Assign




Assign the job to the system. As soon the customer is selected, the system displays previously done jobs, or allows to create a new one. Customer numbers, job numbers, work sequence, dimensions, surface and much more can be defined and if you like, use any common webcam to take a snapshot of the product. Add shipping date, priority, write some comments and hit OK.

Your job is now assigned in the system and waits for the release by the production supervisor.



Release



The job sits in the queue, sorted by shipping date and waits to be released. The production supervisor can now edit and change the complete job, and change priorities. When ready, acknowledge the production steps and release the job for production.

Ready!

Track

The job is now in production and cannot be modified anymore. Once the Traveller is scanned at a production step station, the software changes the status of the manufacturing process. When all steps are done, the

Supervisor can end it and print out the delivery note and send an email to the customer.

Whatever will be done at the end, the software is custom made for every application.
